

NOTICE OF PROPOSALS
AMBER VALLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL
(OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AND CONSOLIDATION) NO.1 ORDER
2009

Amber Valley Borough Council proposes to make the above Order (the Proposed Order) under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (RTRA 1984), as amended, and under the Traffic Management Act 2004 (TMA 2004), as amended, and all other enabling powers.

The effect of the Proposed Order would be as follows:

- a) To revoke the Amber Valley Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2009.
- b) To extend the charging hours at pay and display parking places to include Sundays.
- c) To re-designate the following parking places from short stay to long stay:
 - Beech House, Ripley
 - Whysall Street (west), Heanor
- d) To re-designate Whysall Street (east), Heanor from long stay to short stay.
- e) To divide Cromford Road, Ripley car park into two separate parking places known as Cromford Road car park and Town Hall car park as specified on the plans accompanying the Proposed Order.
- f) To apply the charging hours to the newly designated Cromford Road car park from Mondays to Sundays.
- g) To apply the charging hours to the newly designated Town Hall car park from Saturdays to Sundays (only vehicles authorised by the Council may use the parking place from Monday to Friday).

The daily charges for pay and display parking places are set out in Schedule 1.

General Provisions

Unless specified otherwise in Schedule 2, the following provisions shall apply:

- The classes of vehicles which may use the parking places are passenger vehicles (excluding taxis), light goods vehicles, vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge, motor cycles or classes of vehicles specifically prescribed at each parking place.
- All vehicles must be parked wholly within the markings of a single parking bay where provided.
- All parking places shall be in operation on all days and during all hours unless specified otherwise.

Stays not exceeding 30 minutes	40p
Stays not exceeding 1 Hour	50p
Stays not exceeding 2 Hours	70p
Stays not exceeding 4 Hours	£1.50
Stays exceeding 4 hours	£2.30

Scale of Charges in Pay and Display Car Parks in Heanor

Stays not exceeding 30 minutes	30p
Stays not exceeding 1 Hour	40p
Stays not exceeding 2 Hours	60p
Stays not exceeding 4 Hours	£1.00
Stays exceeding 4 Hours	£1.90

Parking Places

Part 1 – Pay and Display

The charging hours are 8am to 6pm Mondays to Sundays inclusive (no charges on Bank Holidays except for Good Friday), unless stated otherwise. The charging hours do not apply to motor cycles.

Only vehicles displaying a permit issued by or on behalf of the Council may use the parking place between the hours of 6pm to 8am Mondays to Fridays inclusive and all day on Sundays.

When a fair is being held only vehicles authorised by the Council may use the parking place.
- Beech House
When a fair is being held only vehicles authorised by the Council may use the parking place.
- Wellington Street
- Moseley Street
- Slack Lane

Short Stay Car Parks

The maximum period for which vehicles may wait in short stay car parks shall be 2 hours (return prohibited within 1 hour) between the hours of 8am and 6pm unless stated otherwise. There is no maximum period for which motor cycles may park in short stay car parks.

Taxis only permitted to park in the taxi rank. The charging hours do not apply to taxis parked in the taxi rank. There is no maximum period for which taxis may wait in the taxi rank.

Heanor

When a fair is being held only vehicles authorised by the Council may use the parking place. When a market is being held only vehicles authorised by the Council may use the area or areas designated for use for the market. The maximum period for which vehicles may wait is 1 hour (return prohibited within 2 hours) between the hours of 8am and 6pm.

Ripley

- Malthouse Yard
When a fair is being held only vehicles authorised by the Council may use the area or areas designated for use of the fair.

The charging hours and scale of charges do not apply to vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge.
- Market Place
When a fair is being held only vehicles authorised by the Council may use the parking place. When a market is being held only vehicles authorised by the Council may use the area or areas designated for the use of the market.

Alfreton Leisure Centre Car Park

Only vehicles authorised by the Council and displaying a permit issued by or on behalf of the Council may use Alfreton Leisure Centre Car Park for the date and for the times (if any) specified on the permit.
